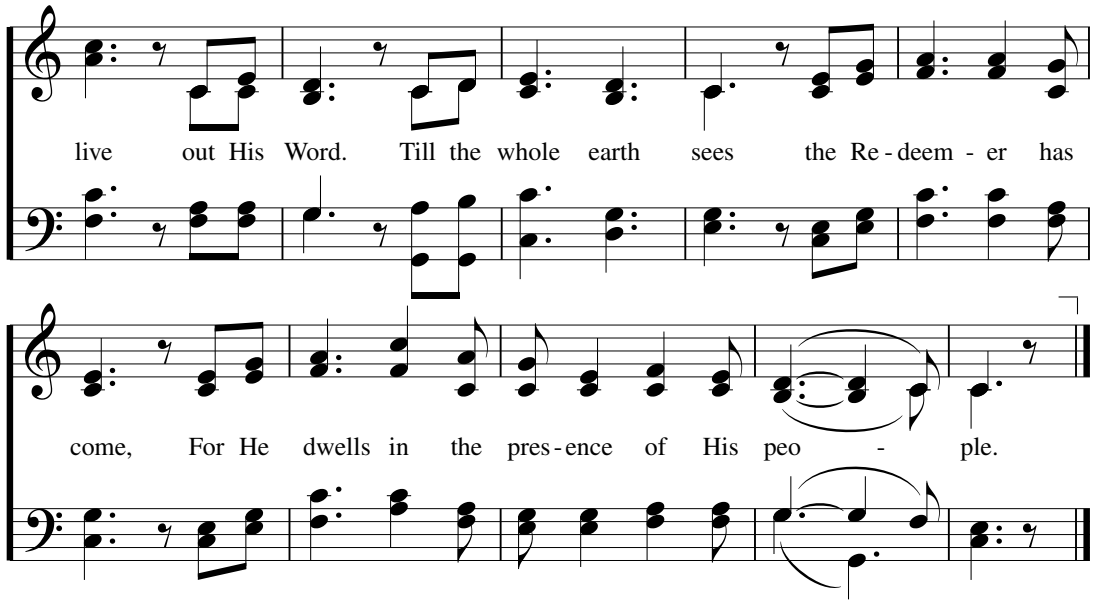

³² He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, how will he not also with him graciously give us all things?

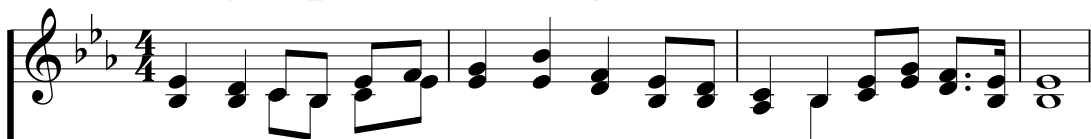
³³ **Who shall bring any charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies.**

³⁴ **Who is to condemn? Christ Jesus is the one who died—more than that, who was raised—who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is interceding for us.**

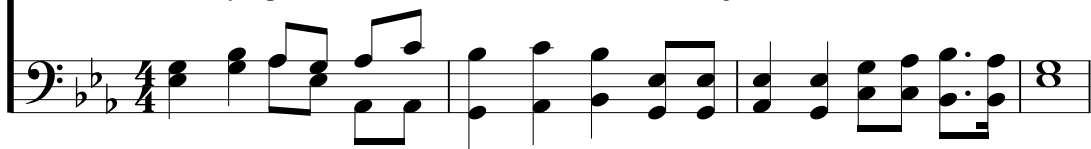

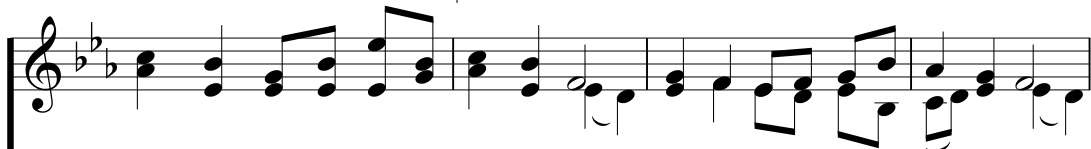
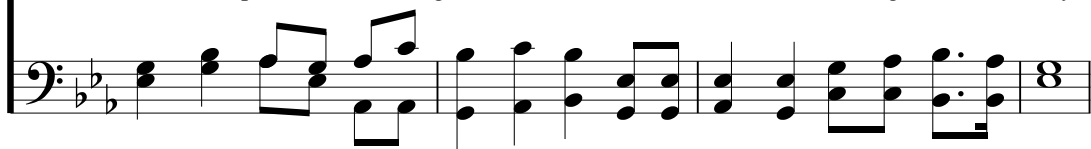
