### **Search Committee Update:**

Many have been asking concerning the progress, if any, of the Search Committee. The questions are legitimate and we want to give a brief summary of where the committee is and what we are doing.

The committee consists of the 6 Elders and 4 members of the congregation with Sam Mason as the chairman. We meet on the fourth Sunday after the Fellowship Dinner. We need/desire your continued prayers.

When a name of a candidate comes to our attention, we follow a rather rigorous procedure to try to determine if there is a "fit" between the man and our needs. This involves a phone interview and a sequence of forms that are filled out by the applicant. At any time, by consensus of the committee, a candidate can be dropped or continued in the process. We as a committee have looked at about 25 men. At the present time, we are looking at 2 men who are at differing stages of evaluation. We trust the Lord to make His will known as we proceed with these two. If others come up, they will be started in the process and it will continue until we have the right man for us. You are welcome to ask for progress reports, as long as you realize any report will be exceedingly general. We will try to give this written report after every meeting or after some especially significant decision.
